

SOIL 230 Pedology Field School

This 24-h introductory soil science course is fully field-based. The 3-day field school led by Dr. Konstantin Dlusskiy focuses on hands-on experience with application to industry standards.

- Description of soil pits and landscapes
- Field diagnostics of soil properties and processes
- Soil classification to Subgroup level of the *Canadian System of Soil Classification*
- Soil sampling protocols
- Hazards associated with ground disturbance and the *Alberta One Call* procedure
